

Eva Doll Instructions

- 1. Outline pattern pieces on fabric with chalk, soap, or fabric pen.
- 2. Cut out fabric.
- 3. Lay out pieces on Front Base and pin in place.
- 4. Sew pieces onto Front Base.
- 5. Place the Front and Back Base to face each other (the in-sides will be facing out).
- Sew Front and Back Base together with a 1/2" seam allowance. Leave a 4" opening.
- 7. Turn the Doll outside-sides facing out.
- 8. Fill with stuffing.
- 9. Close the 4"opening.

- Scissors
- Chalk, soap, or fabric pen
- Needle
- Thread
- Yarn or embroidery thread
- Pins
- Fabric
- Stuffing
- Beads (for Nun Doll)

Eva Doll Pattern Pieces

Nun Pattern Pieces

- Doll Base: cut two
- Nun Veil: cut one
- Doll Face: cut one
- Doll Hair: cut one
- Nun Hands: cut one

Heroine Pattern Pieces

- Doll Base: cut two
- Heroine Body: cut one
- Doll Face: cut one
- Doll Hair: cut one
- Heroine Hair: cut one
- Heroine Hand: cut one
- Heroine Sword Hand: cut one
- Skull: cut one
- Sword Handle: cut one
- Sword Blade: cut one

Mummy Pattern Pieces

- Doll Base: cut two
- Doll Face: cut one
- Mummy Hand: cut two
- Head Wrap: cut one
- Wrap A: cut one
- Wrap B: cut one
- Wrap C: cut one

Doll Size

There are two sizes of patterns. The one on 8 1/2" x 11" paper makes a 13 3/4" tall doll. The one on 11" x 17" paper makes a 17" doll.

Note: Body Pattern comes on two pages. Cut both out. Over-lap the two pieces. Match up the dashed line. Connect the two pieces together.

Stitches
